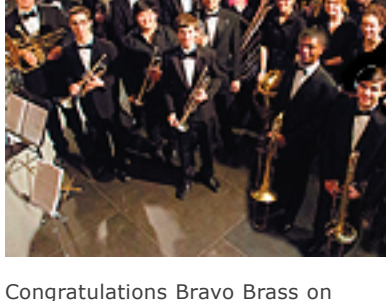

Our inaugural concert of November 17th boasted an unprecedented 1120 audience patrons. This outpouring of support for our flagship orchestra was a record-breaking attendance for our concerts at the Kimmel Center. I encourage you to continue spreading the word, inviting friends and family, and promoting all of our amazingly dedicated students across our six ensembles. Also last fall, the Parent Alliance meetings took root and activities and fundraising efforts are now well underway. 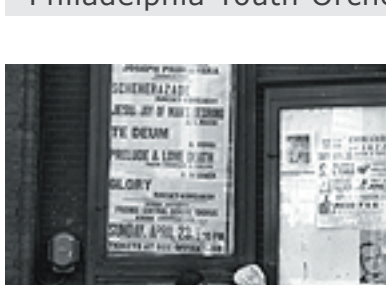


Great Lakes Scrip yields great rewards for non profits.
