Instrument: Oboe + English Horn

Audition Requirements:

Oboe performers should play

- 1) required scales
- 2) their own selection from the solo repertoire
- 3) the attached required orchestral excerpts.

In addition:

Oboes should play or be willing to learn to play English horn. If the student does play English horn, please be prepared to play the provided excerpt as a part of the audition.

PYAO Woodwinds Required Scales

Scales: 2 major scales, all major keys; <u>quarter note</u> equals 116 BPM **or** <u>half note</u> equals 100 BPM

Flute

C major 3 octaves <u>articulated</u> using a rhythmic pattern of your choice D flat major 2 octaves <u>slurred</u> using a rhythmic pattern of your choice

Oboe

E major 2 octaves <u>articulated</u> using a rhythmic pattern of your choice F major 2 octaves <u>slurred</u> using a rhythmic pattern of your choice

Clarinet

G major 3 octaves <u>slurred</u> using a rhythmic pattern of your choice E major 3 octaves <u>articulated</u> using a rhythmic pattern of your choice

Bassoon

B flat major 3 octaves <u>articulated</u> using a rhythmic pattern of your choice A major 2 octaves slurred using a rhythmic pattern of your choice

PYO Music Institute – Recommended Solo Repertoire

- 1) The works listed in this document are <u>recommendations</u> for the Solo Repertoire component of your PYOMI audition. These are <u>not</u> the Required Excerpts for your PYOMI audition. (Required Excerpts are listed separately in this packet.)
 - Select the Solo Repertoire piece that you perform for your audition by using the recommended works listed below as a guide, in consultation with your private teacher.
- 2) The PYO Music Institute adjudication faculty will be listening for: precise rhythmic execution, your ability to play in time, good individual intonation, and a solid and accurate representation of your technical proficiency.
- 3) <u>Woodwinds Only:</u> Please <u>do not</u> present any solo specifically written for an <u>unaccompanied</u>

instrument. For example, the following are regarded as unacceptable choices:

Flute: Syrinx by Debussy

Clarinet: Three Pieces by Stravinsky

Oboe: Metamorphoses by Britten

Bassoon: Parable by Persichetti

Students should be proficient in the major concerto or solo repertoire and demonstrate a mature sound and musical maturity.

- Haydn Oboe Concerto in C Major, VIIg/C1 (Mvt. I)
- Hindemith Oboe Sonata (Mvts. I or II)
- Mozart Oboe Concerto in C Major, K. 314 (Mvt. I)
- Saint-Saens Oboe Sonata in D Major, Op. 166 (Mvts. II or III) (or equivalent)


