Instrument: Bass Trombone

Audition Requirements:

Trombone performers should play

- 1) required scales
- 2) their own selection from the solo repertoire
- 3) the attached required orchestral excerpts.

In addition:

Trombones should be able to read bass clef and tenor clef, and be willing to learn to read alto clef.

PYAO Brass Scale Requirements

Trumpet

- -G major 2 octaves articulated using a rhythmic pattern of your choice quarter note equals 120 BPM or half note equals 100 BPM
- -C major 2 octaves slurred using a rhythmic pattern of your choice quarter note equals 116 BPM or half note equals 100 BPM

Horn

- -F major 2 octaves articulated using a rhythmic pattern of your choice quarter note equals 116 BPM or half note equals 100 BPM
- -A major 2 octaves slurred using a rhythmic pattern of your choice quarter note equals 116 BPM or half note equals 100 BPM

Trombone

- -F major 2 octaves articulated using a rhythmic pattern of your choice quarter note equals 116 BPM or half note equals 100 BPM
- -Bb major 2 octaves slurred using a rhythmic pattern of your choice quarter note equals 116 BPM or half note equals 100 BPM

Tuba

- -F major 2 octaves articulated using a rhythmic pattern of your choice quarter note equals 116 BPM or half note equals 100 BPM
- -Bb major 2 octaves slurred using a rhythmic pattern of your choice quarter note equals 116 BPM or half note equals 100 BPM

PYO Music Institute – Recommended Solo Repertoire

- 1) The works listed in this document are <u>recommendations</u> for the Solo Repertoire component of your PYOMI audition. These are <u>not</u> the Required Excerpts for your PYOMI audition. (Required Excerpts are listed separately in this packet.)
 - Select the Solo Repertoire piece that you perform for your audition by using the recommended works listed below as a guide, in consultation with your private teacher.
- 2) The PYO Music Institute adjudication faculty will be listening for: precise **rhythmic execution**, your ability to **play in time**, good individual **intonation**, and a solid and accurate representation of your **technical proficiency**.
- 3) Woodwinds Only: Please do not present any solo specifically written for an unaccompanied

instrument. For example, the following are regarded as unacceptable choices:
Flute: Syrinx by Debussy

Clarinet: Three Pieces by Stravinsky

Oboe: Metamorphoses by Britten

Bassoon: Parable by Persichetti

Students should be proficient in the major concerto or solo repertoire and demonstrate a mature sound and musical maturity.
