Instrument: Violin

Audition Requirements:

Violinists should play

- 1) required scales
- 2) their own selection from the solo repertoire
- 3) the attached required excerpts.

Prysm Strings Scale Requirements

Prysm Prep:
Violin
2 one octave scales of the students' choice, any speed

Prysm Strings Young Artists:

Violin

1 Major scale and 1 Minor scale (in key of your choice) both in 2 octaves, separate bows at quarter equals 60, in quarters and eighths.

Prysm Strings:

Violin

1 Major scale and 1 Minor scale (in key of your choice) both in 3 octaves, seperate bows at quarter equals 72, in quarters and eighths

- The works listed in this document are <u>recommendations</u> for the Solo Repertoire component of your PYOMI audition. These are <u>not</u> the Required Excerpts for your PYOMI audition. (Required Excerpts are listed separately on the PYOMI website.)
 Select the Solo Repertoire piece that you perform for your audition by using the recommended works listed below as a guide, in consultation with your private teacher.
- 2) The PYO Music Institute adjudication faculty will be listening for: precise **rhythmic execution**, your ability to **play in time**, good individual **intonation**, and a solid and accurate representation of your **technical proficiency**.
- 3) <u>Woodwinds Only</u>: Please <u>do not</u> present any solo specifically written for an <u>unaccompanied</u>

instrument. For example, the following are regarded as unacceptable choices: Flute: Syrinx by Debussy

Clarinet: Three Pieces by Stravinsky

Oboe: Metamorphoses by Britten

Bassoon: Parable by Persichetti

Repertoire should demonstrate knowledge of positions, use of vibrato, and knowledge of keys using at least four sharps and four flats.
