Instrument: Double Bass

Audition Requirements:

Bass performers should play

- 1) required scales
- 2) their own selection from the solo repertoire
- 3) the attached required orchestral excerpts.

PYSB Strings Scale Requirements

Bass

D major scale and B melodic minor, 2 octaves required, 3 octaves preferred Quarter note equals 84 BPM

Play in quarters, eighths, and sixteenths. Single bows, détaché stroke
