Instrument: Tenor Saxophone

Audition Requirements:

All Saxophone performers should play

- 1) required scales
- 2) their own selection from the solo repertoire
- 3) the attached required orchestral excerpts.

PYCB Woodwinds Required Scales

Scales: 2 major scales, using keys up to 4 flats and 4 sharps; <u>quarter note</u> equals 120 BPM **or** half note equals 80 BPM

AltoSax:

C Major 3 octaves <u>articulated</u> using a rhythmic pattern of your choice A Major 3 octaves <u>slurred</u> using a rhythmic pattern of your choice

Tenor Sax:

F Major 3 octaves <u>articulated</u> using a rhythmic pattern of your choice C D Major 3 octaves <u>slurred</u> using a rhythmic pattern of your choice

Baritone Sax:

C Major 3 octaves <u>slurred</u> using a rhythmic pattern of your choice A Major two octaves <u>articulated</u> using a rhythmic pattern of your choice

PYO Music Institute – Recommended Solo Repertoire

- 1) The works listed in this document are <u>recommendations</u> for the Solo Repertoire component of your PYOMI audition. These are <u>not</u> the Required Excerpts for your PYOMI audition. (Required Excerpts are listed separately in this packet.)
 - Select the Solo Repertoire piece that you perform for your audition by using the recommended works listed below as a guide, in consultation with your private teacher.
- 2) The PYO Music Institute adjudication faculty will be listening for: precise rhythmic execution, your ability to play in time, good individual intonation, and a solid and accurate representation of your technical proficiency.
- 3) Woodwinds Only: Please do not present any solo specifically written for an unaccompanied

instrument. For example, the following are regarded as unacceptable choices:
Flute: Syrinx by Debussy
Clarinet: Three Pieces by Stravinsky
Oboe: Metamorphoses by Britten
Bassoon: Parable by Persichetti

- Telemann Flute Sonatas (Any Movement)
- Bach Any Gigue

Oboe

Any sonata by Vivaldi, Telemann, or Handel, fast and/or slow movements

Clarinet

- C. Stamitz Concerto No. 3 in B flat (Mvts. I or III)
- Weber Concertino in E-flat, op. 26 (Page 1)

Bassoon

- Gordon Jacob Four Sketches
- Fasch Bassoon Sonata in C Major, FaWV N/C1

Saxophone

- Teal Melodies for the Young Saxophonist
- Vereecken Alto Saxophone Solos Book 1
